### **Palette**

DecoArt Americana
Wedgewood Blue
Winter Blue
Williamsburg Blue
Tomato Red
Soft Black
Milk Chocolate
Golden Straw
Buttermilk
Light Buttermilk

DeLane's Cheek Color

Hilite Flesh

### **Brushes**

Loew – Cornell Angular – ½" and ¾" Bette Byrd Scroller Liner – 6/0 Loew – Cornell Fabric Dye Brush - #2

## Prep

Sand then seal wood with Delta Ceramcoat Varnish and sand and seal again Trace pattern on, leaving out detail lines

#### **BUNNY**

Basecoat as follows:
Buttermilk – Bunny
Williamsburg Blue – Overalls
Soft Black – Head of ladybug
Tomato Red – Body of ladybug
Trace detail lines

#### SHADING AND HIGHLIGHTING

Milk Chocolate – Shade bunny behind the head on the ears, under the chin, behind the overalls on the arms, down the arms and under the overalls on the feet, also make a back to back float to divide the feet; basecoat the nose; make a dot for the mouth and line from mouth to the nose

DeLane's Cheek Color – Stipple cheeks and inside ears Soft Black – Shade left side of nose Light Buttermilk – Highlight nose and feet, with a dry brush stroke Hilite Flesh – Dots on cheeks

#### **LADYBUG**

Soft Black – Shade ladybug and make spots Buttermilk – Dot eyes

#### **OVERALLS**

Wedgewood Blue – Shade overalls down the sides and make a back to back float to divide the legs; shade at the shoulders and under the straps
Winter Blue – Stipple highlights on center of belly, knees, cuffs and straps
Tomato Red –Basecoat hearts and do stitching lines on overalls
Golden Straw – Buttons on overall straps

# **Details**

Micron .005 Pen – Eyes on bunny and outline your work as much as you like

## **Finishing**

Krylon Spray – Give bunny one light coat
Milk Chocolate – Spatter bunny lightly
Krylon Spray – Give Bunny several light coats to finish
